## Hand Foot Mouth Disease

## Etiology

Cocksackievirus A16 virus Enterovirus

## **Presentation**

Common in children < 10 years old
Ulcerative oral lesions and vesicular
exanthems develop on distal extremities
Mild constitutional symptoms present
Fever, sore throat, and malaise present for a
few days

Lesions start in the mouth, and are later present in the feet/hands

## **Treatment and Course**

Typically a self-limiting condition

Symptomatic treatment is indicated if needed
