Perioperative Management of Patients Receiving Anticoagulants

• Warfarin

- Discontinue 5 days prior to an elective surgery
- 1/2 life of warfarin is 36-42 hours

• Dabigatran - direct thrombin inhibitor

- Discontinue 1 day prior to low/moderate bleeding risk surgery
- Discontinue 2 days prior to high bleeding risk surgery

• Rivaroxaban and Apixaban- direct factor Xa inhibitors

- Discontinue 1 day prior to low/moderate bleeding risk surgery
- Discontinue 2 days prior to high bleeding risk surgery

• Lovenox (LMWH)

- Discontinue 24 hours prior to surgery
 - often used for anticoagulation bridging

• Heparin (UFH)

- Discontinue 4-6 hours prior to surgery
 - often used for anticoagulation bridging

Antiplatelet medications (Aspirin and Plavix)

- ***Consult with cardiology/PCP if these medications can be held
- Discontinue 7 days prior to surgery in low risk cardiac patients
