Prurigo Nodularis

Definition

 -chronic skin condition presenting with very pruritic nodules/bumps
 -most commonly presents on the arms, legs, back, torso

Associated with the following conditions:

<u>Atopy -- atopic dermatitis, asthma, allergic rhinitis</u>
(50% of AD cases develop prurigo nodularis)
-Diabetes mellitus
-Hepatic/renal disease
-HIV/AIDS
-Thyroid conditions
-gluten enteropathy
-psychiatric disorders

Pathogenesis:

-increased number of nerve fibers in the papillary dermis -presence of Th2 cytokines -cutaneous small fiber neuropathy

Treatment

-requires a multidisciplinary approach

- 1) Patient education to reduce skin irritation/scratching
- 2) Symptomatic management of pruritis
- 3) Topical / systemic therapies to disrupt itch/scratch cycle
