SOFA Score

(Sequential Organ Failure Assessment Score)

SOFA Score

o Tool to identify patients at risk of dying from sepsis (assesses morbidity and mortality risk)

Definitions

- Sepsis
 - Life-threatening organ dysfunction caused by a dysregulated host response to infection
 - SOFA score can be used to ID which patients are at greatest risk of "life-threatening" organ dysfunction

Septic Shock

■ SOFA score ≥ 2 with a vasopressor requirement & an elevated lactate > 2 mmol/L (>18 mg/dL)

SOFA score is based on the following

- 1. Respiratory System
- 2. Cardiovascular system
 - a. blood pressure
 - b. need for vasopressors
- 3. Hepatic system bilirubin level
- 4. Coagulation system
 - a. platelet concentration
- 5. Neurologic system
 - a. Glasgow coma score
- 6. Renal system
 - a. serum creatinine or urine output

qSOFA Score

(modified version of SOFA score)

*only has 3 components

- 1. Respiratory rate > 22 / minute
- 2. Altered mentation
- 3. Systolic blood pressure < 100 mmH

*Score \geq 2 --> poor outcome due to sepsis
