Definition


• Detected in 1 of 2 findings that are present for **3 or more months**

- urinary albumin excretion of \geq 30 mg/day **OR**
- estimated glomerular filtration rate < 60 mL/min</p>

KDIGO 2023 CLINICAL PRACTICE GUIDELINE FOR THE EVALUATION AND MANAGEMENT OF CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE

CKD is <u>defined</u> as abnormalities of kidney structure or function, present for > 3 months, with implications for health. CKD is <u>classified</u> based on <u>Cause</u>, <u>GFR</u> category (G1-G5), and <u>A</u>lbuminuria category (A1-A3), abbreviated as CGA.



Green, low risk (if no other marker of kidney disease, no CKD); Yellow, moderately increased risk; Orange, high risk; Red, very high risk. GFR; glomerular filtration rate
