Ottawa AnkleRules

- Help determine the need for ankle and/or foot radiographs following injury
 - clinical judgment should supersede these rules
 - e.g. patients with neuropathy or intoxicated patients may not exhibit pain

Ottawa Ankle Rules

- Plain radiographs are indicated in the following situations:
- 1. Bone tenderness at the posterior edge or tip of the lateral or medial malleolus (distal 6 cm of the fibula)
- 2. Bone tenderness at the base of the 5th metatarsal or navicular
- 3. unable to weight bear immediately after the injury and for 4 steps in the emergency dept/doctor's office

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
